

Q5 planning guidance...

- 20 marks – 20 mins
- Focus on CHANGE and CONTINUITY (for the Medieval paragraph, was there change within the time period, for the later paragraphs compare level of change to previous time period)
- Look carefully at the TOPIC of the question – e.g. is it a question about the nature of crime, or the causes?
- Structure – 4 paragraphs and conclusion
- Refer to change / continuity within each paragraph – biggest change, identify areas of continuity, comment on scale of change (how much)
- Conclusion – summarise scale of change, time period with most change, biggest single change overall, main area of continuity
